A tax rate of \$0.18706 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Lee College District.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Lee College District from the same properties in both the 2024 tax year and the 2025 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Lee College District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Lee College District is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON October 16, 2025 AT 6:00 pm AT John B Tucker Hall, 200 Lee Drive, Baytown, Texas 77520.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Lee College District is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of Lee College District at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.
